



**ROUTE 1: 93 Miles (3 Hours)**  
**Fitzgerald's Vienna Woods Hotel, Glanmire, Co. Cork**

This route starts out with a nice dual carriage way out of Cork where at Midleton the road reverts to single lane and continues deep into the heavily wooded East Cork areas of Castlemartyr and Youghal. This drive had a good mix of scenery including some costal sections and an architectural bridge coming into Dungarvan, at which point you will be in county Waterford. Dungarvan is a beautiful sea-side town perfect as the midway stop for this route. The return leg of the journey brings you deeper into the Irish countryside with slightly smaller roads where you will pass through numerous rural villages before breaking your way on to the new motorway for the last 30 mins of the journey back to Fitzgerald's Vienna Woods hotel. The highlight of this route is the mixture of scenery, and road types.

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**ROUTE 2: 120 Miles (4 Hours)**  
**Fitzgerald's Vienna Woods Hotel, Glanmire, Co. Cork**

This route in contrast takes you into West Cork, and onto Killarney, one of the most scenic parts of Ireland. Using Killarney as the half way point the journey is in 2 nice two hour sections of 60 miles each. The first leg of the journey you will see the country side change into rugged rural Ireland, roads are bendy and hilly, but surface is good. The highlight of this route is the Derrynahaggart Mountains with gentle hills you are in no time in an enchanting wilderness, which opens up on to fantastic straights right into Killarney town. The second leg of this journey is more rural, road surfaces are still good but narrower, you are still on an A road. You will travel into East Limerick as you hit Malinbeg with its really high bridge and continue south into Cork city where the final part of your journey back to Fitzgerald's Vienna Woods' Hotel will let you sight see Cork city.
